1 Corinthians 15:50-58

## Context

The apostle Paul wrote the book of 1 Corinthians to apply the gospel to life of the Corinthian believers and deal with the various problems in their church. In 1 Corinthians 15, Paul defends the resurrection from those who would claim that it could never actually happen. But Paul ends 1 Corinthians 15 with an important exhortation for the Corinthians, and even for us today.

Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-58

1. Why can't flesh and blood inherit God's kingdom (15:50)?
2. What will happen after the dead are resurrected (15:51-55)?
3. How has God given Christians the victory over death (15:56-57)?
4. What difference does it make that we will be resurrected (15:58)?

## Application Questions

1. How should Christ's resurrection and the hope of your own bodily transformation affect your priorities?
2. In what area of the Christian life has it been a struggle to stand firm?
3. What encouragement can we take from the fact that our work in the Lord is not in vain?
4. In what specific way do you need to be committed to the work of the Lord?
