ANNA AND SIMEON (LUKE 2:22-39)

January 01

Brite Idea: Jesus is for all people.

He Question: Who is Jesus?

Jesus is the Savior who God promised to send from the very beginning. God sent His Son Jesus to make a way for all people to be saved from sin and have a restored relationship with God.

Memory Verse: "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes." **Romans 1:16a**

We Question: Why doesn't everyone choose to follow Jesus?

Jesus is for everyone, but all have a choice. Because we live in a sinful and fallen world, many people choose to follow themselves instead of following Him. Each person must decide for themselves to trust in Jesus.

BOY JESUS (LUKE 2:41-52)

January 08

Brite Idea: Jesus lived in complete obedience to God.

He Question: What was Jesus like as a kid?

Jesus was a kid just like me. But unlike me, Jesus lived in complete obedience to God from the moment He was born. Jesus was both fully God, and fully man.

Memory Verse: "And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man." **Luke 2:52**

We Question: How can we grow in our relationship with God like Jesus did?

We can grow in our relationship with God by following Jesus' example.
 Jesus studied God's Word, prayed honestly to God, listened to wise teachers, and asked questions.

TEMPTATION OF JESUS AND REJECTION IN NAZARETH (LUKE 4:1-30)

January 15

Brite Idea: Jesus understands our struggles.

He Question: Does Jesus really know what it's like to be human?

Jesus knows exactly what it's like to be human. Jesus faced temptation and was rejected by many people. Even though Jesus never sinned, He understands our struggles.

Memory Verse: "For because He himself has suffered when tempted, He is able to help those who are being tempted." **Hebrews 2:18**

We Question: How do I deal with temptation and rejection?

Jesus showed us how to deal with temptation and rejection. When Jesus was tempted, He fought back against lies with the truth of God's Word. When Jesus was rejected, He didn't lash out or insult the crowd, He continued to lovingly speak the truth to them.

JESUS CALLS THE DISCIPLES (LUKE 5:1-11, 27-31, 6:12-16)

January 22

Brite Idea: Jesus can change your life.

He Question: Who does Jesus call to follow Him?

Jesus calls all people to follow Him. It doesn't matter how much you know or what you've done, anyone can accept the call to follow Jesus.

Memory Verse: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation."

2 Corinthians 5:17a

We Question: What does someone have to do to follow Jesus?

We don't have to fix our lives or change anything about ourselves to start following Jesus. All that is needed to follow Jesus is to believe in Him and we will be saved!

TRANSFIGURATION (LUKE 9:28-36)

January 29

Brite Idea: Jesus is God's Son.

He Question: How is Jesus different from other great teachers or leaders?

While great teachers and prophets pointed people towards God, Jesus IS God. He has the power to change lives and set people free from sin.

Memory Verse: "And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is my Son." **Luke 9:35a**

We Question: How does Jesus being the Son of God affect my life?

If Jesus was just a good man or great teacher, He could point us towards God but He would not have the power to forgive us from sin and restore our relationship with God. Because Jesus is the Son of God, we can trust in His power to save us.
