CONTEXT

STUDY QUESTIONS

Read Matthews 21:1-11

1. What is the significance of Jesus' triumphal entry? How does it fulfill Old Testament prophecy?
2. Why do you think Jesus chose to enter Jerusalem riding on a donkey?
3. How do the crowds respond to Jesus' entry into Jerusalem? What expectations of Jesus do you think they had?
4. How do the Pharisees react to Jesus' entry? What does their response reveal about their perception of Jesus?

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Reflect on how you welcome Jesus into your life. Are there areas where you need to invite Him to reign as King, just as the people did in Jerusalem?
2. How does Jesus' example challenge us to embrace humility in our interactions with others?
3. "Hosanna" is a cry of praise and salvation. How can we offer authentic worship to Jesus in our daily lives, not just with our words but also with our actions and attitudes?
