Family

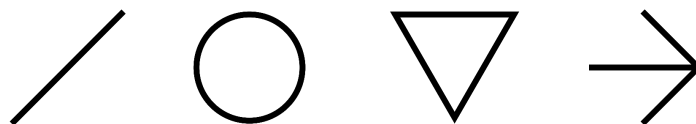
We are adopted children of God who love one another like family
